

Fourth Grade Rules

Fourth grade classroom rules will mirror our school-wide SWEBS rules. Students will be rewarded for their positive behaviors with SWEBS tickets. However, if there are times when a student's behavior is not what is expected or greater than expected, the student's behavior will be noted by use of a color chart with various levels of discipline.

Classroom Rules

1. Follow directions the first time given.
2. Listen and respond to others.
3. Respect others by working quietly.
4. Word and play safely.
5. Respect others' space and property.
6. Keep personal space and desk neat and organized.

Behavior Color Chart

Excellent Job!
Great Job!
Ready to Learn!
Make Better Choices! (Warning)
Lose Recess
Parent Call/Office

1. Children will begin each day with the color green (Ready to Learn!). This means that they are exhibiting appropriate behavior.
2. Children will receive one warning for inappropriate behavior. The color will change to blue (Make Better Choices!).
3. If behavior persists, the student's color will be moved to yellow which indicates a loss of recess.
4. If behavior continues after yellow, the student's color will be moved to red which means a visit to the principal's office or a call home to inform parents of the misbehavior.
5. In addition to consequences, students can move upward on the chart to purple (Great Job!) and orange (Excellent Job!).
